What is Diabetes?

Diabetes is a chronic debilitating disease affecting every organ of the body. There are two basic types:

1. **Type 1** – an autoimmune disease in which a person's pancreas stops producing insulin, a hormone that enables people to get energy from food. Usually strikes in childhood or young adulthood but lasts a lifetime.
2. **Type 2** – a metabolic disorder in which a person's body still produces insulin but is unable to use it effectively. Usually diagnosed in adulthood.

There is no cure for diabetes and the long-term effects include kidney failure, blindness, nerve damage, heart disease and strokes.

About Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF)

JDRF is the leading charitable funder and advocate of type 1 (juvenile) diabetes research worldwide. Originally founded by parents of children with diabetes, the mission of JDRF is to find a cure for diabetes and its complications through the support of research.
